The British Council helps create greater understanding between the UK and the rest of the world.

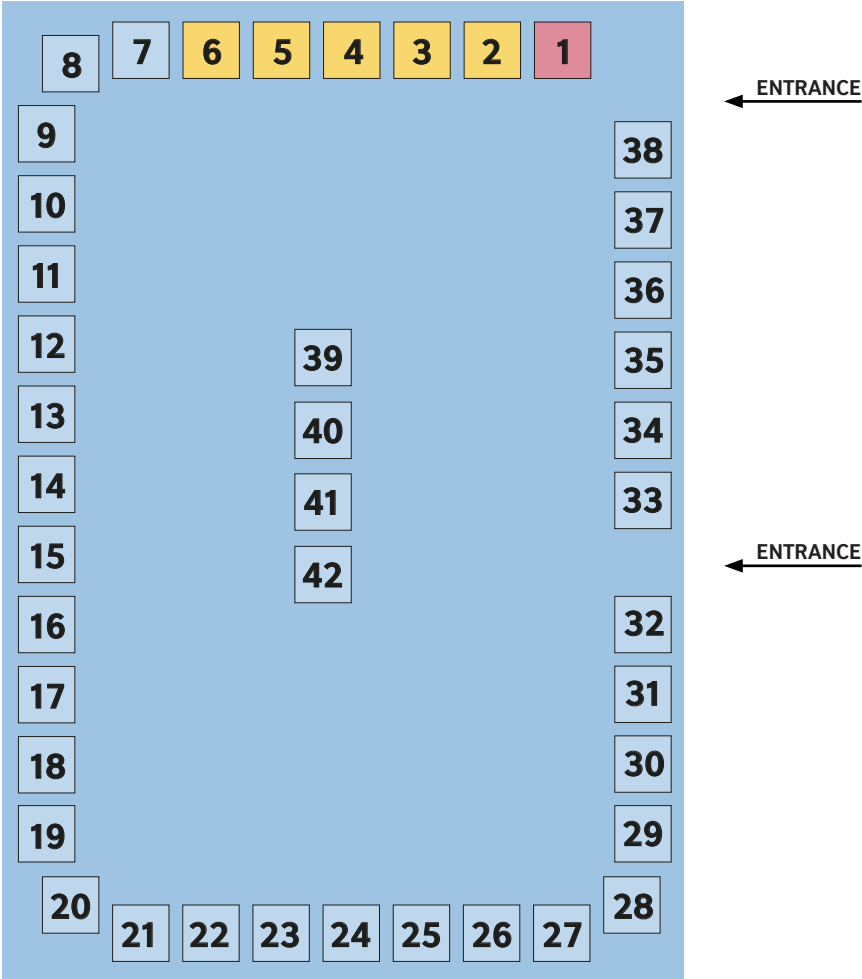

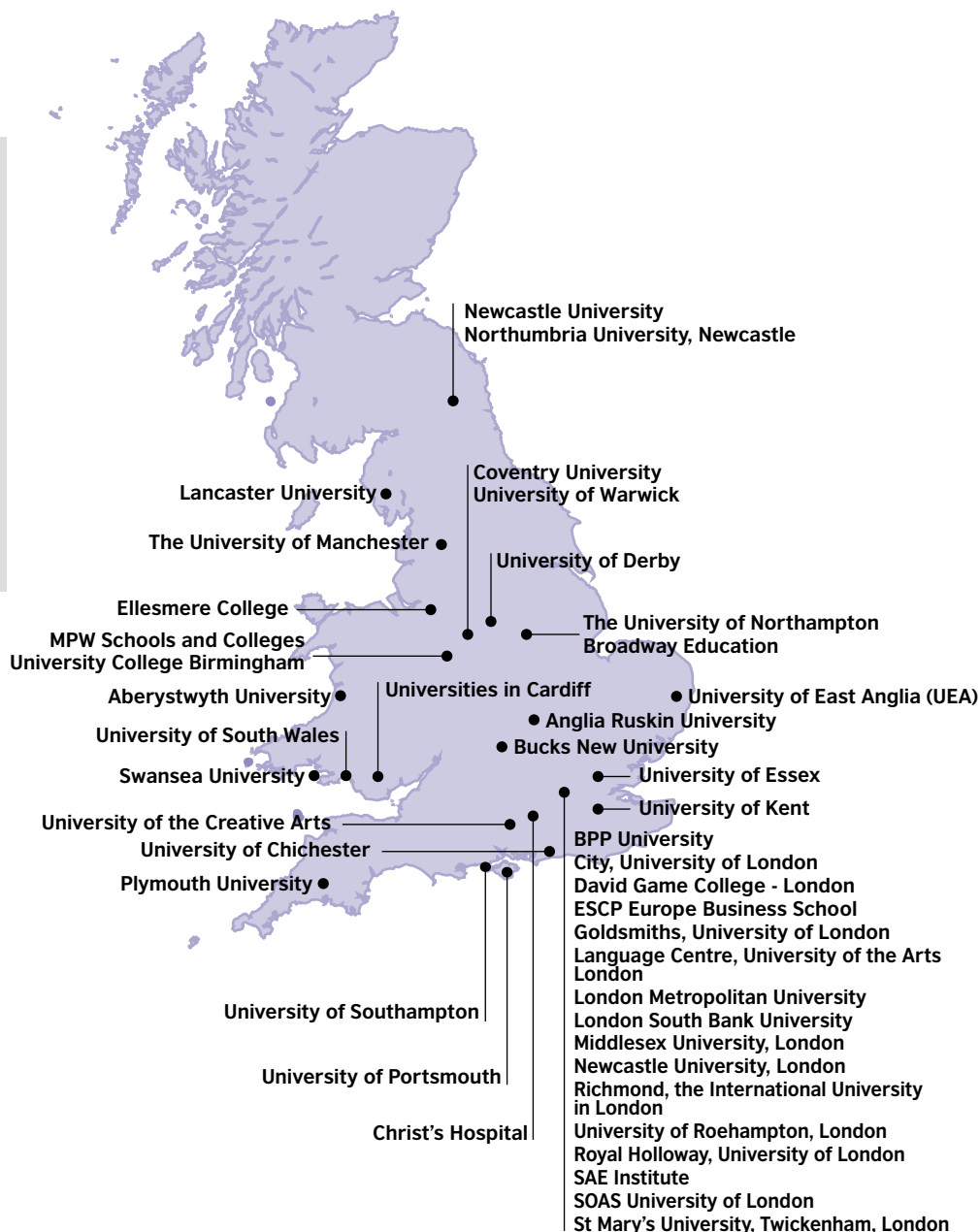
