BOARDING SCHOOLS

UK **boarding schools** are residential schools offering internationally recognised **qualifications such as GCSEs, Scottish Standard Grades and Highers, A-Levels and the International Baccalaureate** in a variety of subjects. They help you to prepare for university, perfect your English language skills and gain an excellent preparation for your future career.

The UK boarding school system is split into three levels:

- Primary education is for children aged 4 or 5 up to 11 or 13. Terms you might hear are primary school, infant school, junior school, pre-preparatory school and preparatory school.
- Secondary education is for pupils aged 11 or 13 to 16. Terms you might hear are secondary school, high school and senior school. The term 'senior school' is more commonly used in the independent sector.
- Sixth form level is for students aged 16 to 18.

There are two types of schools: Independent schools – most boarding schools are independent schools (privately run, also known as "public" schools) and welcome pupils of any nationality. These schools charge fees for tuition and boarding; **State schools** – schools for UK pupils and pupils from the European Economic Area. Tuition is free (funded by the state), but there is a charge for boarding accommodation.

FURTHER EDUCATION

UK Further education helps you to train for a career or get prepared for university. Academic courses prepare you for higher education at a **university or college**. Careerbased vocational and professional courses give you the skills, training and qualifications you need in your chosen career.



HIGHER EDUCATION

Across England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales you'll find great **universities and colleges** which offer you the chance to follow your passion and prepare for the career of your dreams. Being a student in the UK gives you a chance to gain internationally respected qualifications. Here are some of the most popular undergraduate and postgraduate qualifications:

Undergraduate

Bachelor's Degree (BA, BSc, Bed, BEng): full-time courses usually last three or four years, although some may be longer.

Postgraduate

Master's degree (MA, MSc, MRes, MEng): Programmes (taught or research) usually last one year full-time. Part-time and distance learning also available.

MBA: the prestigious Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree covers topics such as business policy and strategy, operational and strategic management and international trade.

Doctorate (PhD, DPhil): the highest academic level of degree, where you pursue a specialist interest. Usually three or four years full-time.

English Language School
